We will replace any old or worn equipment and take action to correct discrepancies that may be identified by the examiner.

4-Your company agrees to keep a copy of the agreement on file near the rental counter for counter personnel to review.

5-Your company agrees to maintain each rental vessel in accordance to the equipment specifications shown during the Vessel Safety Check and per each vessel's the copy of the examination.
