



# **V**D11NR 2012 Statistics\*



# **VPAC AREA 2012 Statistics\***



The goal for D11NR is 12,000 VSC's. We are 85% of our goal for the year and 102% of 2011 production at this time! The data source is AUXINFO\*. Additional stats from AUXINFO\* indicates that 4,750 or 40% of our VSC's are First Time VSC's. In addition, 5,142 or 43% are High Risk VSC's.

There was typo for the VSC total shown in the September stats that showed Div 4 with 1139 VSC's for 2011 The correct total was 422 VSC's. Thanks to Mike Fiamingo SO-VE 4 for catching the error.

However, the special recognition for 60+ VSC's will not change. To qualify for this recognition, your VSC activity performed MUST be entered and shown in AUXINFO PRIOR Monday November 5, 2012!

-A special request from the Director's office; PLEASE have the qualifying members 7038 with the 5 VSC's entered into AUXDATA by the FSO/SO-IS <u>PRIOR</u> to submission of the MT-2 to the Director's office.
